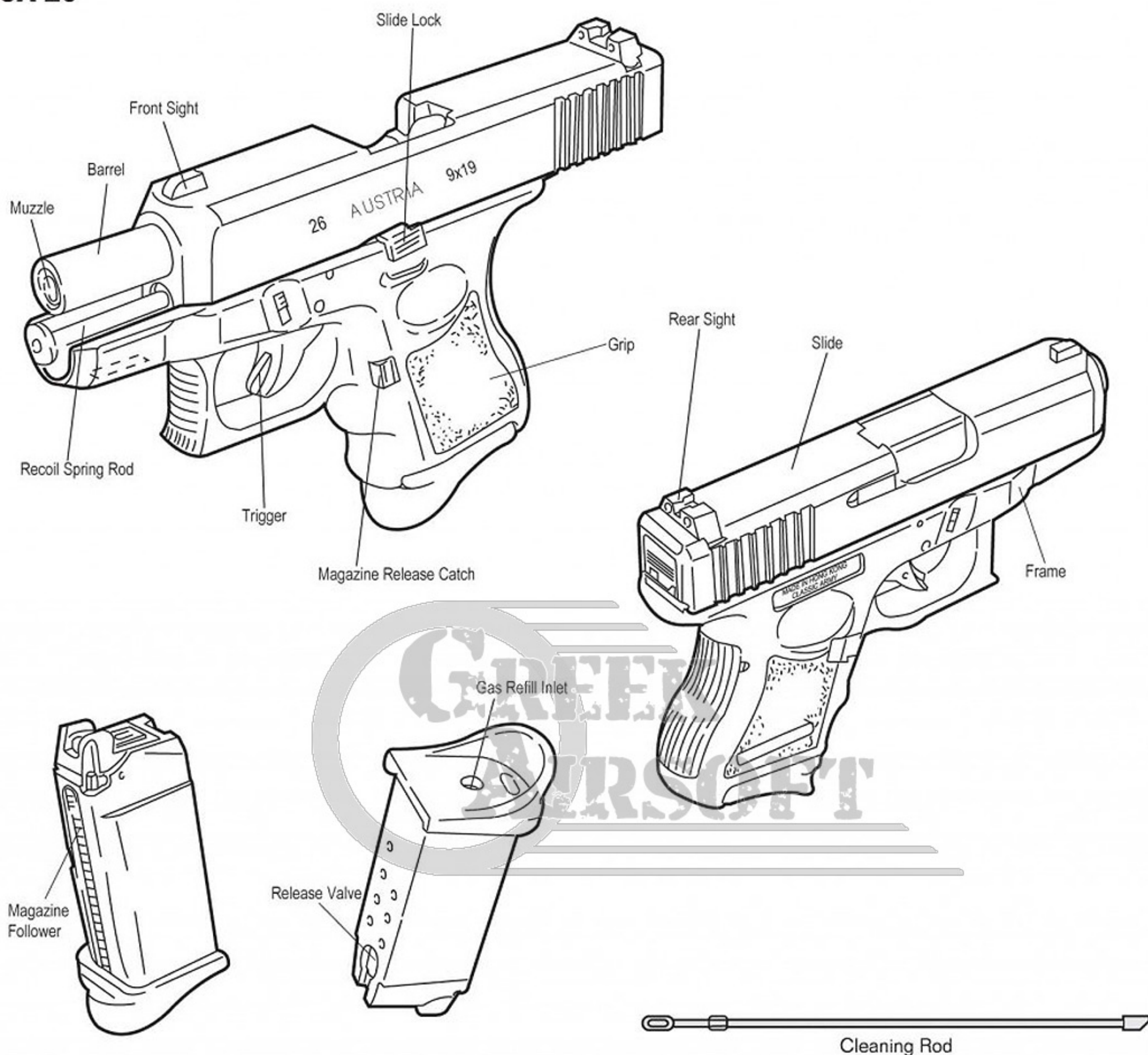

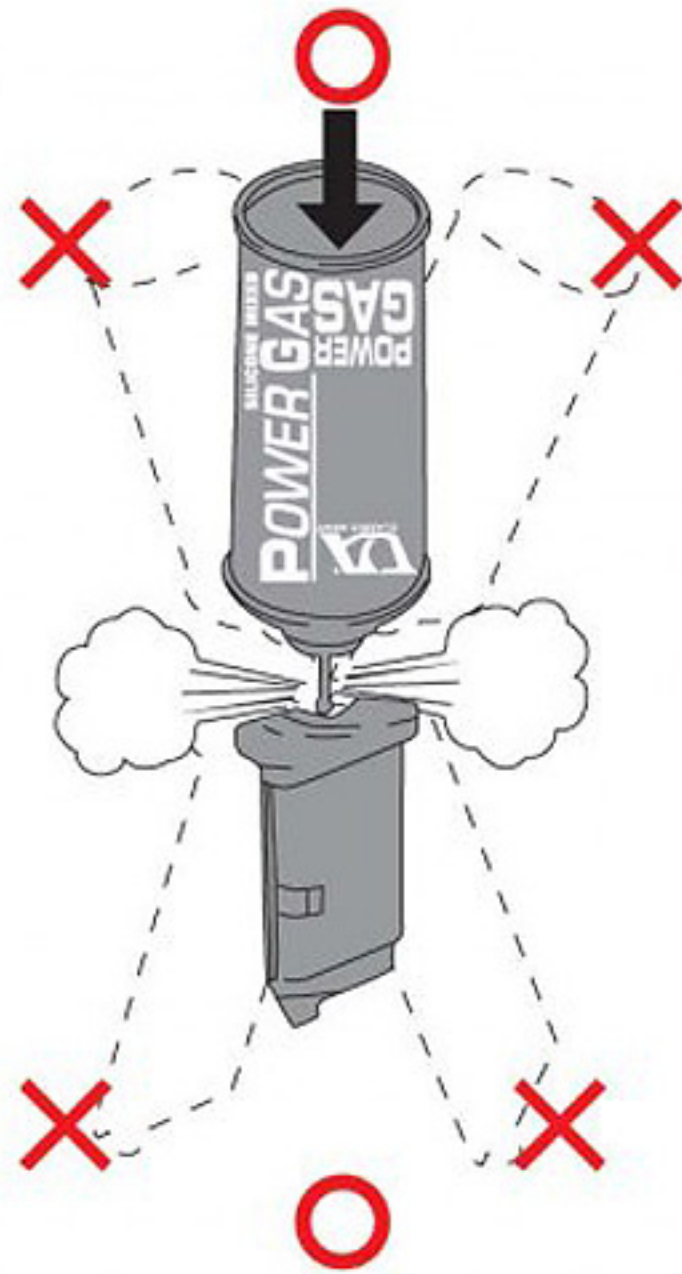

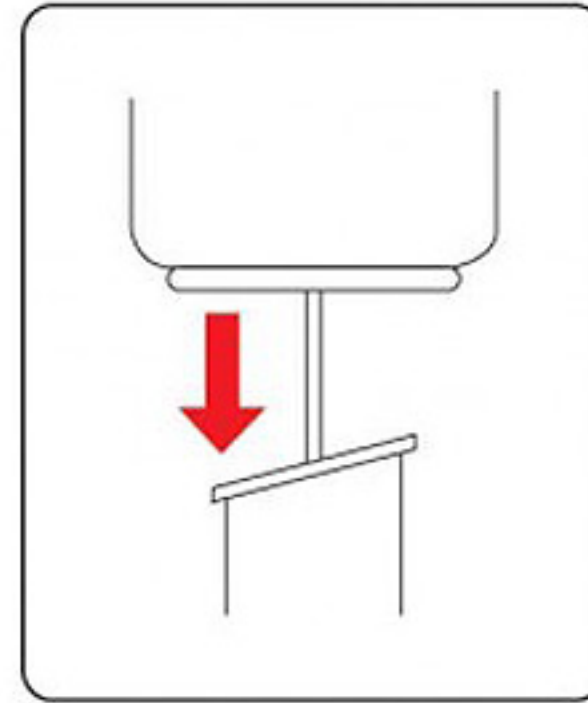


### 3 Operation

#### 1 Gas Injection



To refill the gas with the gas container in vertical position.



Be careful! The releasing gas is harmful to your eyes and face. Avoid facing the magazine directly when you try to release the gas by pressing the release valve.



#### 2 Loading BB Pellet

High precision BB pellets is required for the operation of this magazine. Avoid invasion by dust and dirt into the magazine to prevent malfunctions.

Load BB pellet in the magazine, 6 mm (15 rounds only). Please follow the illustration diagrams to load the BB pellets.



**Never use any used BB pellets**



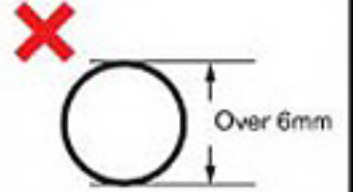

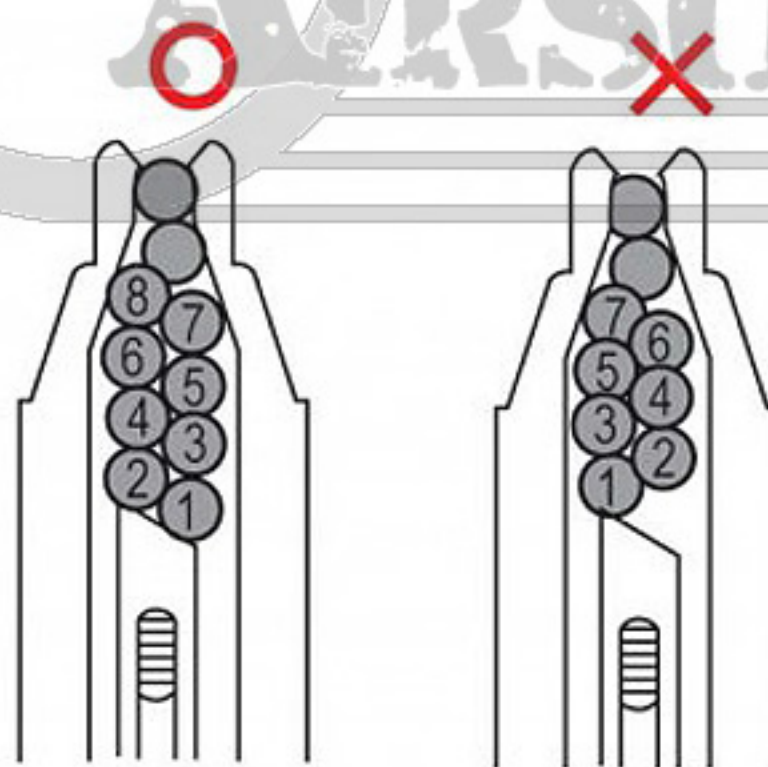
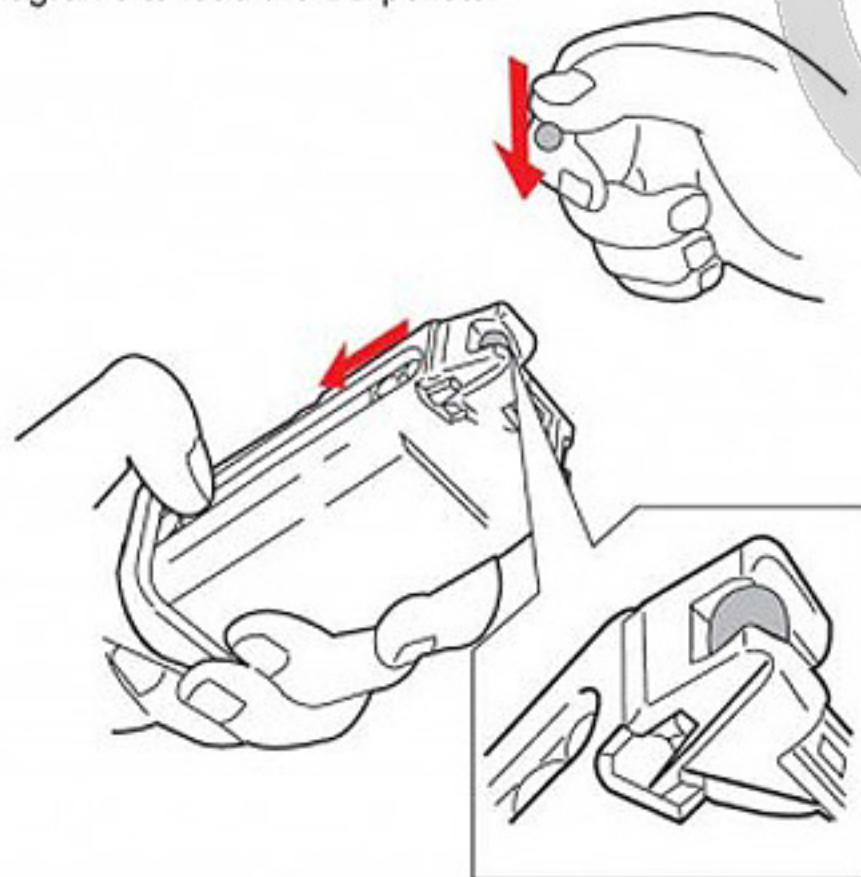
Please don't use the BB pellet which is not completed.



Please don't use the broken BB pellet.



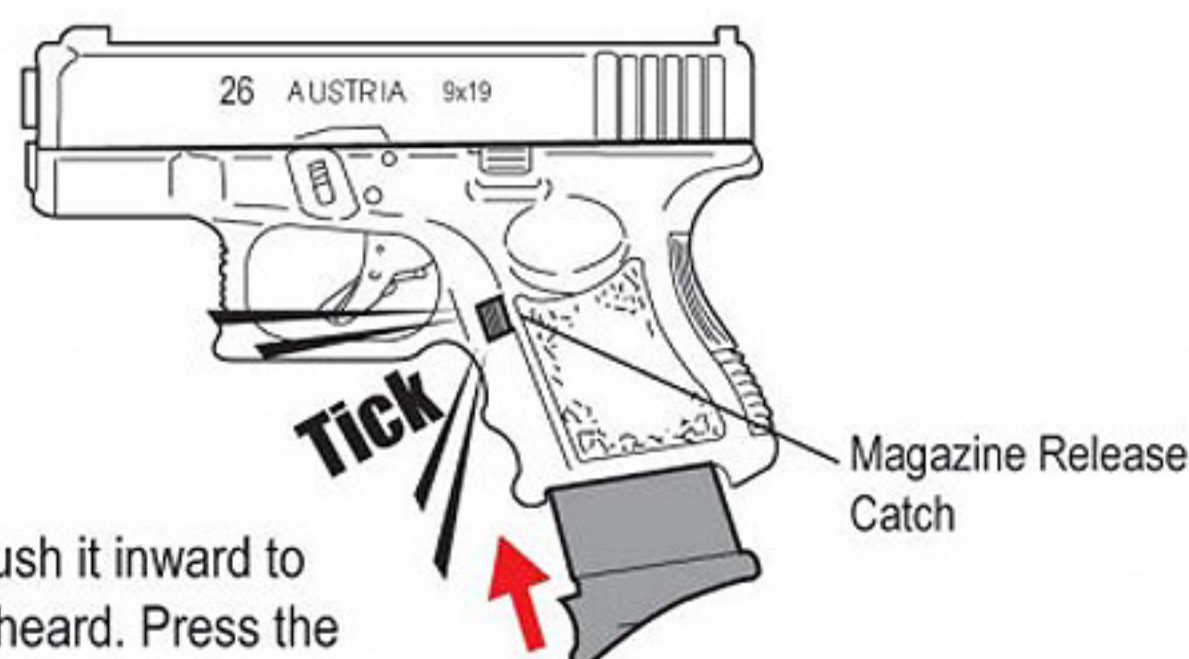
Please don't use the BB pellet which diameter is exceeded 6 mm.



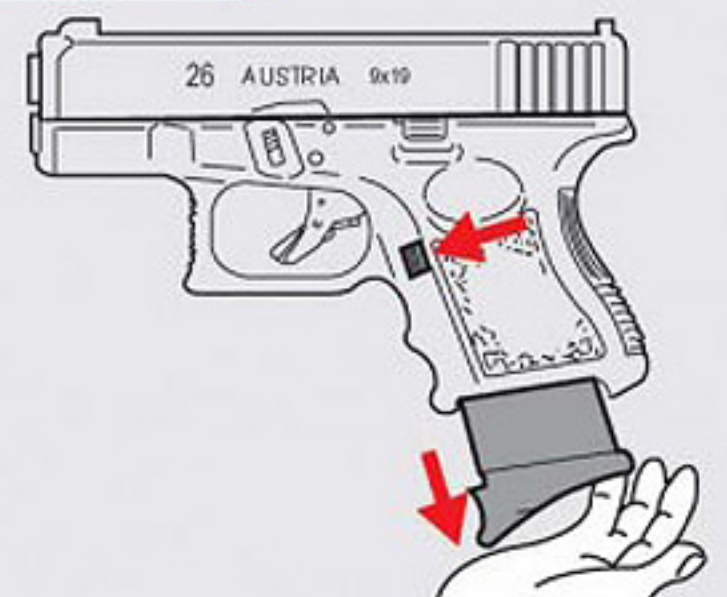
Do not compress and release the magazine spring without BB pellet is loaded. It may be damage the magazine.



#### 3 Loading & Releasing The Magazine



While loading the magazine, push it inward to the bottom till a "tick" sound is heard. Press the magazine release catch, the magazine will fall off from the stock.

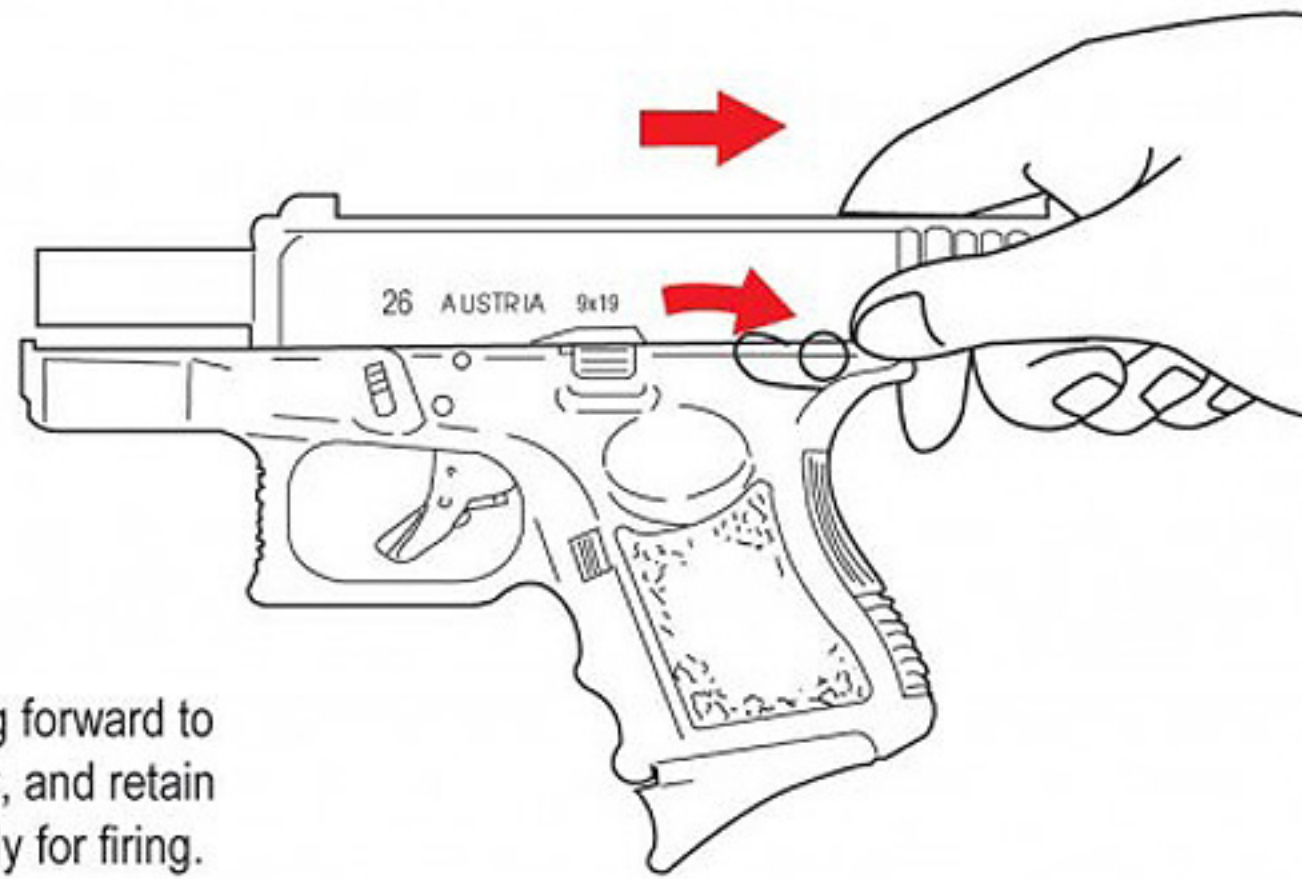


Attention: use hand to receive the magazine to prevent it from falling down to the ground.



## 4 First Load For Firing

1. Pull the slide backward to a specific position.



2. Then release and let the slide moving forward to load the pellet into the firing chamber, and retain the hammer at the rear position, ready for firing.

## 5 Safety Operation

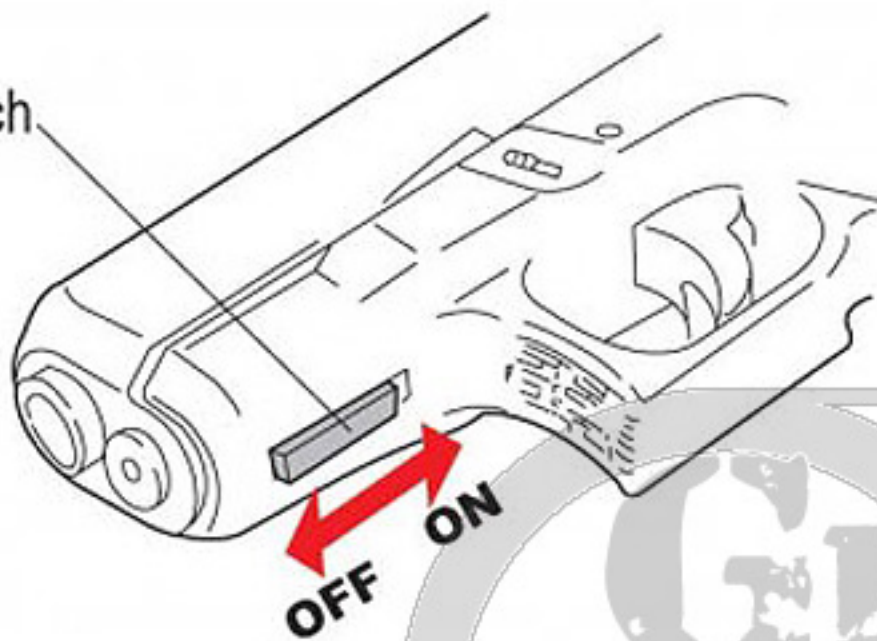


Pistol can only work when the safety switch stays at "OFF" position. Do not operate the trigger when the safety switch is at "ON" position. Otherwise, the pistol may be damaged.

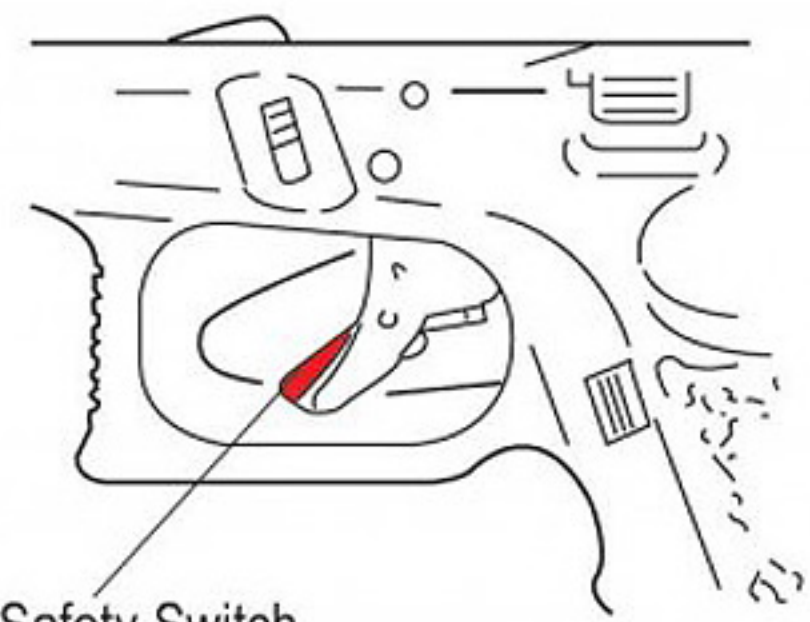


Do not hand your finger on the trigger if you are not shooting.

Trigger Safety Switch

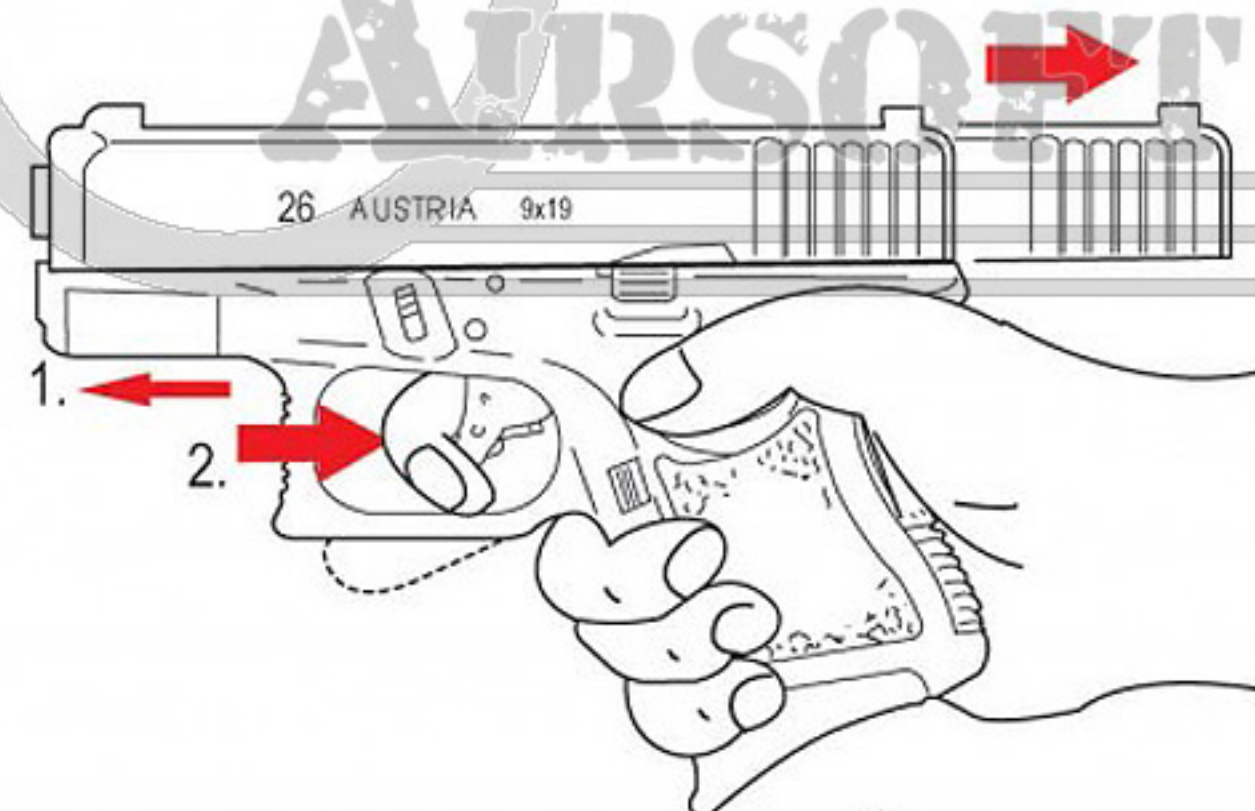


## 6 Shooting

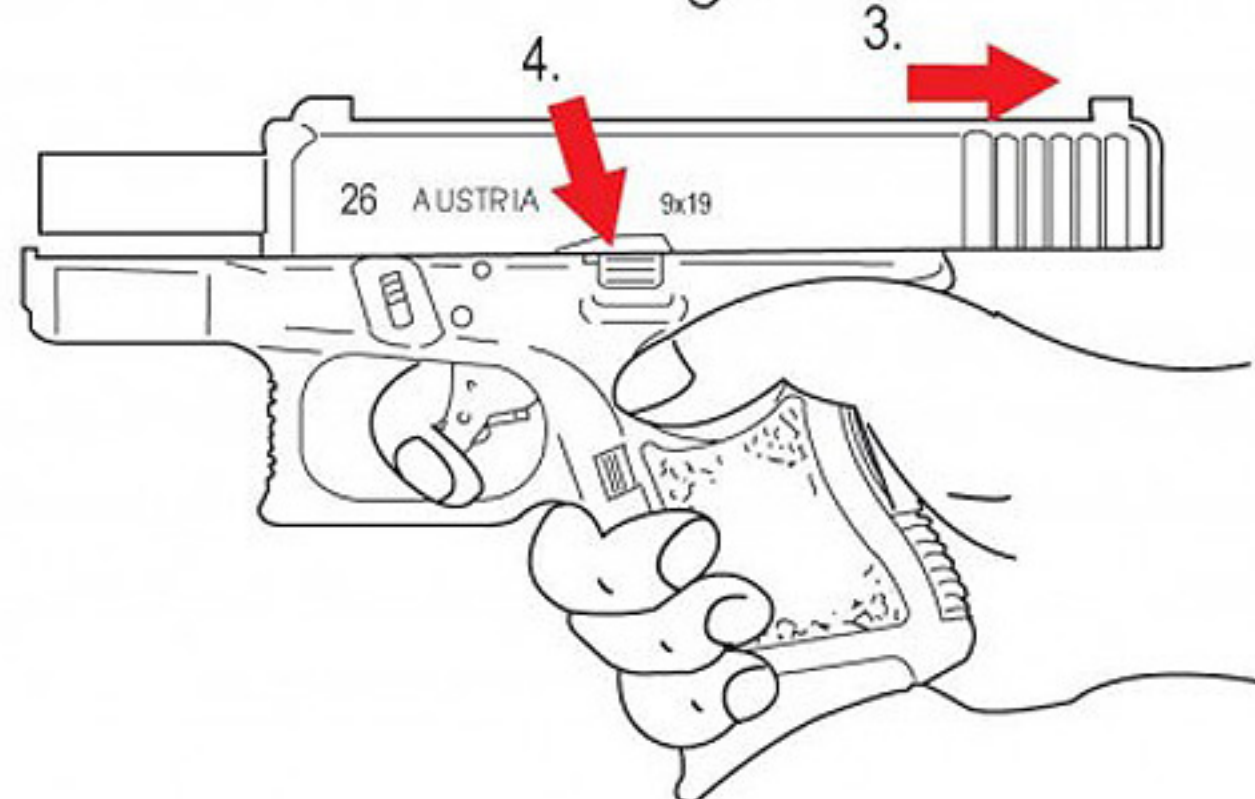


After a long and continued firing practice, the low temperature of the magazine will cause a reduced gas pressure as well as the low velocity of pellet. It is a normal condition and not a trouble.

Never practice the reverse firing because which action causes the gas can not evaporate and the vaporized gas easy to damage the parts.



- 1 When the slide is pulled back and released forward. The BB pellet is loaded in the firing chamber, press the trigger to fire the loaded BB pellet.



- 2 After the last BB pellet is fired, the slide will be retained in the back position, it means an empty magazine condition. If you want to resume the firing, insert a new fully loaded magazine; press the slide lock to release the slide and to reload the BB pellet.



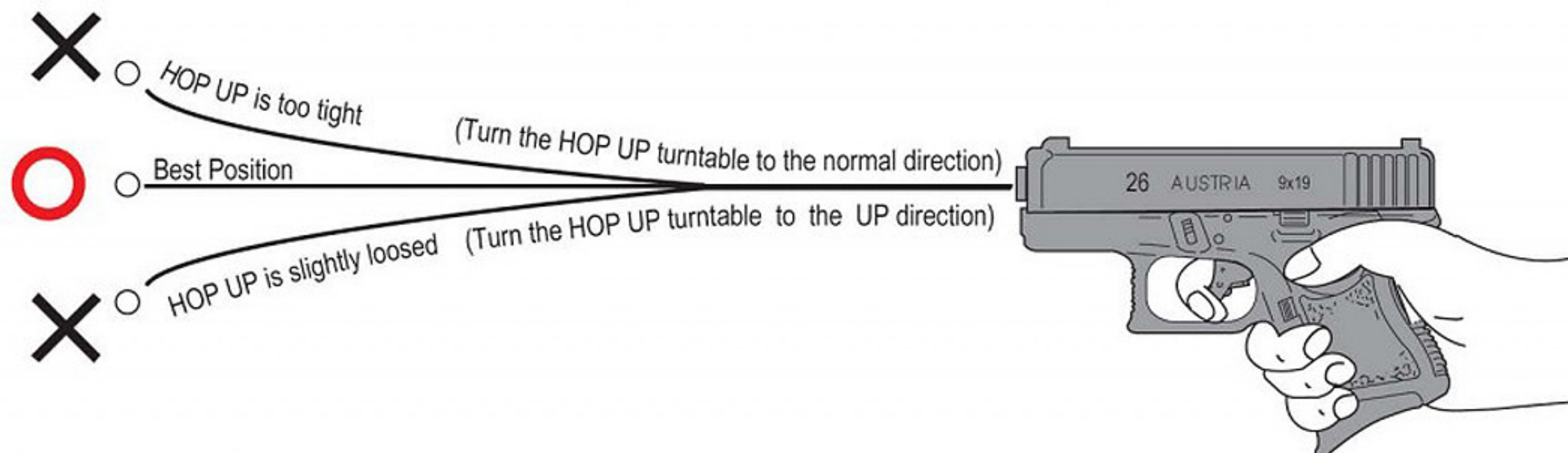

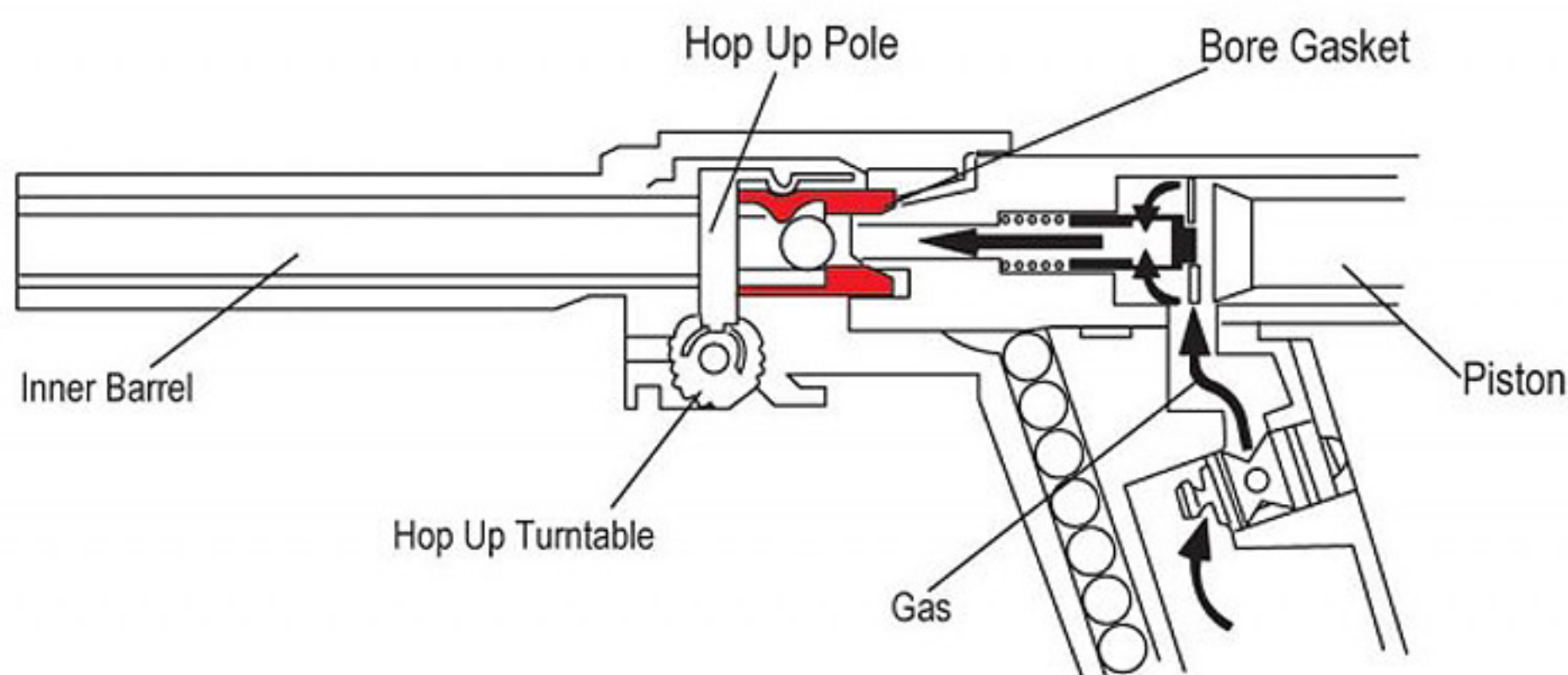
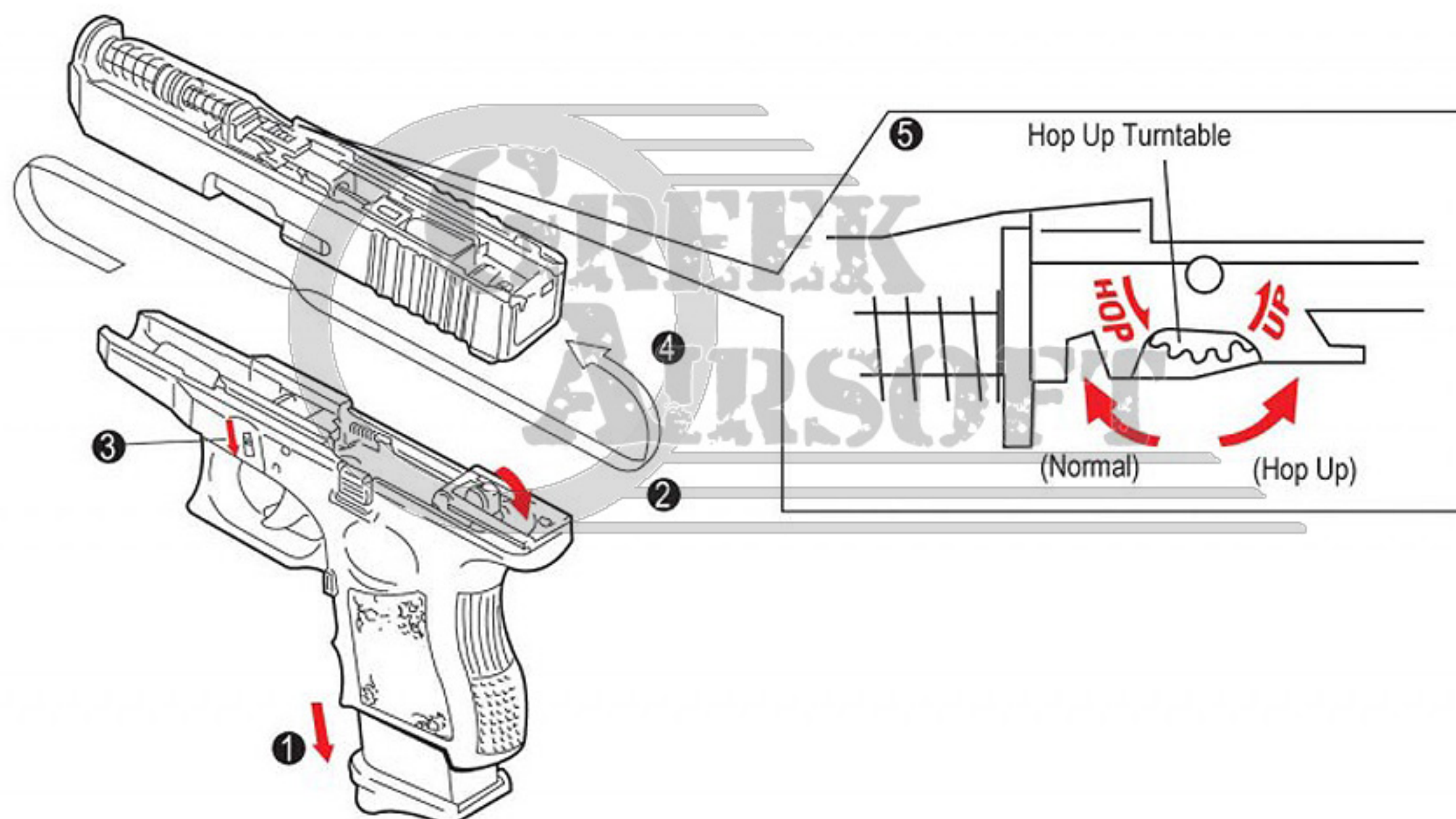
## ⑥ Application of HOP UP

1. The adjustable HOP UP system can make the trajectory of BB pellets slightly adjustable, and compared with the launcher which makes pellets moving at a parabola trajectory, it can aim at a farther target and shoot the pellets for a long range. Unlike the fixed one, the HOP UP turntable and HOP UP Pole can be adjusted slightly by a light touch. It is a wonderful HOP UP system.



2. Adjust the HOP UP in 1~5 sequence.

- Turn the HOP UP turntable slowly towards the "UP" direction till the BB pellets can be shot horizontally.
- Too tightness will cause a poor shooting, so, complete the adjustment till the trajectory is horizontal.
- Forceful turn of the HOP UP turntable to a certain degree may cause damage.

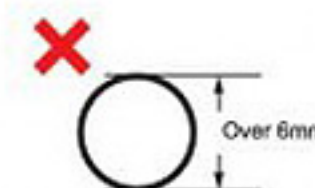

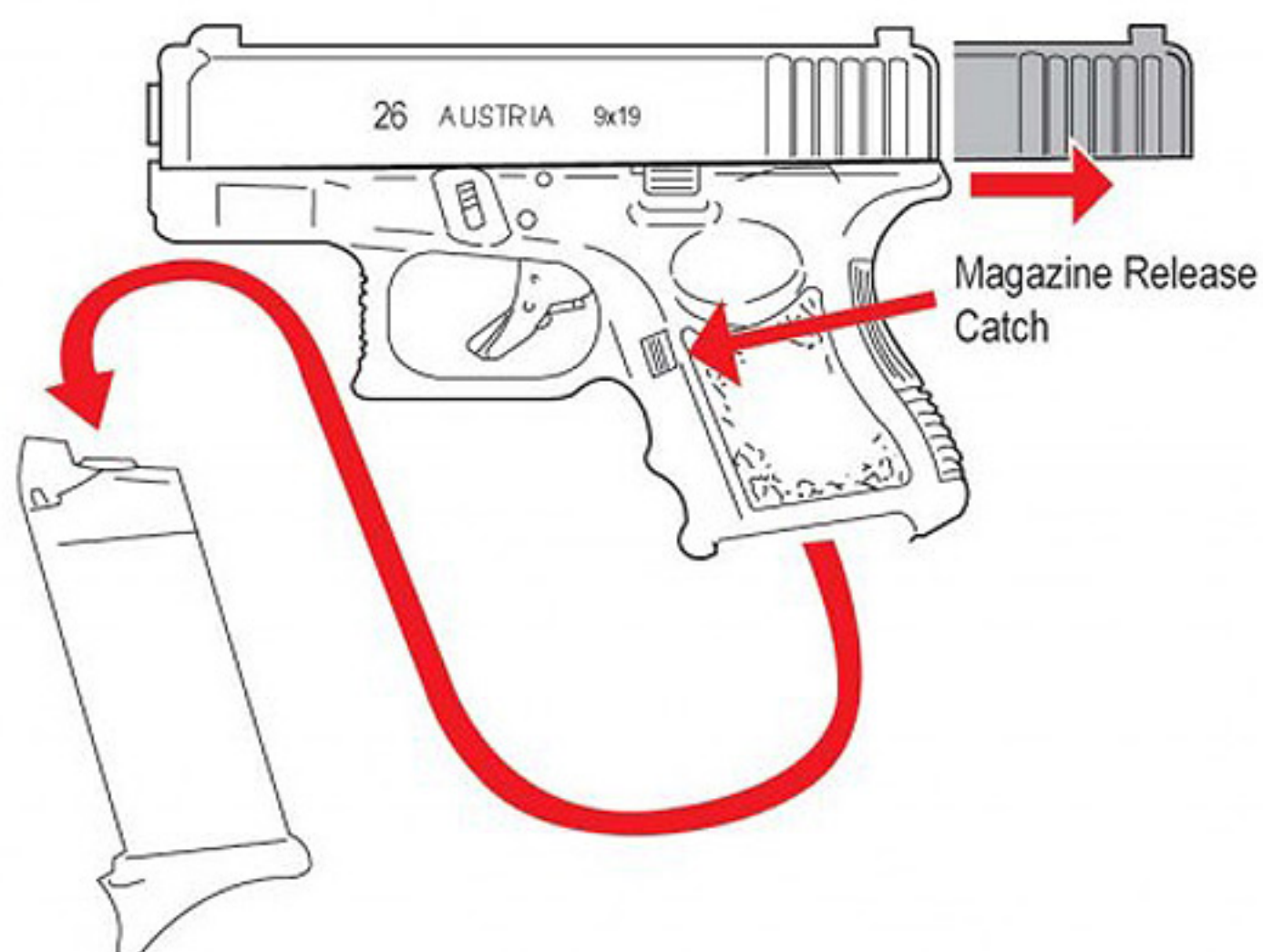

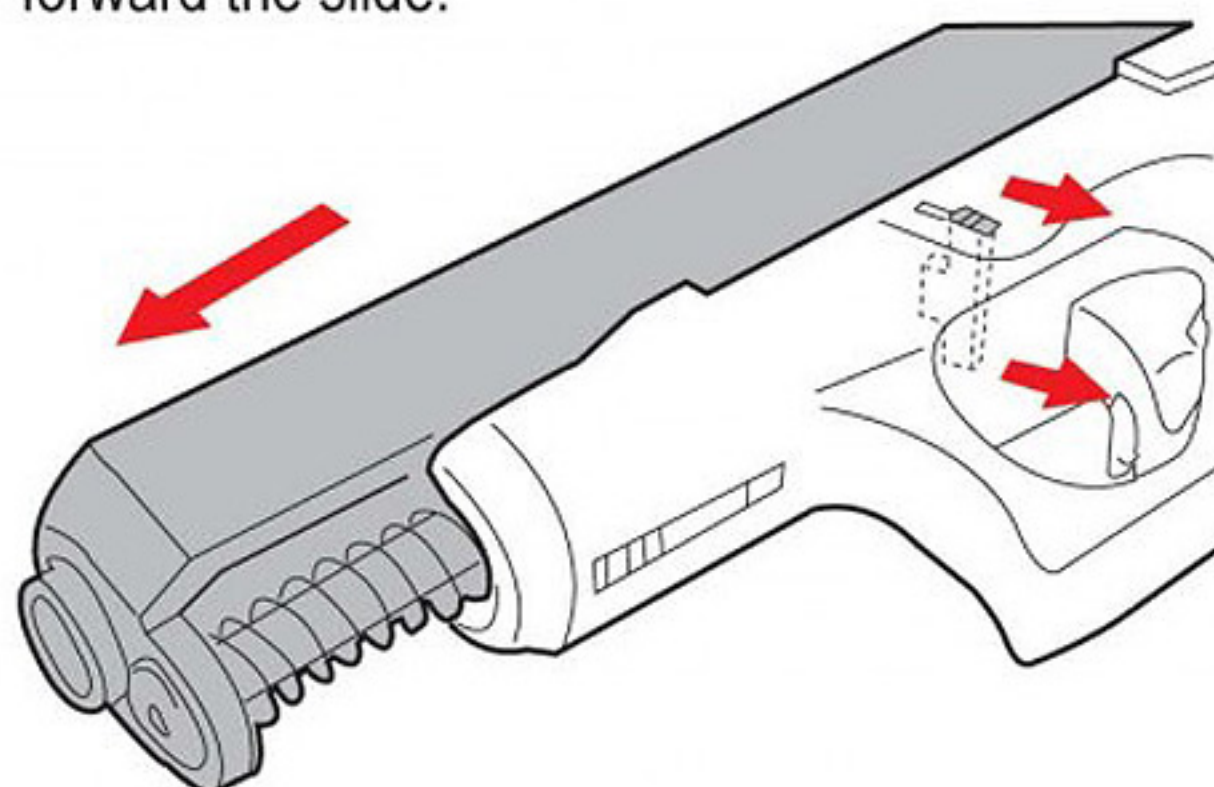


## 4 ① How to disassembly the pistol for basic maintenance

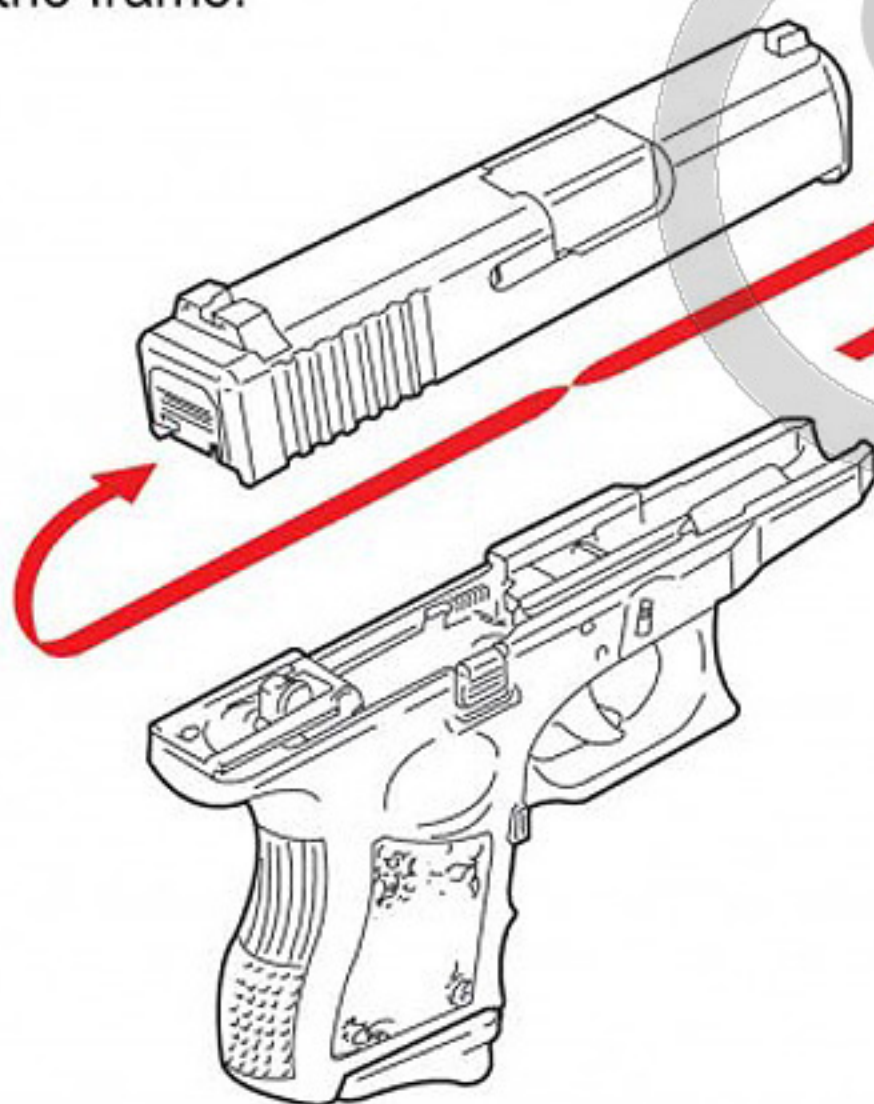
1. Detach the magazine first.



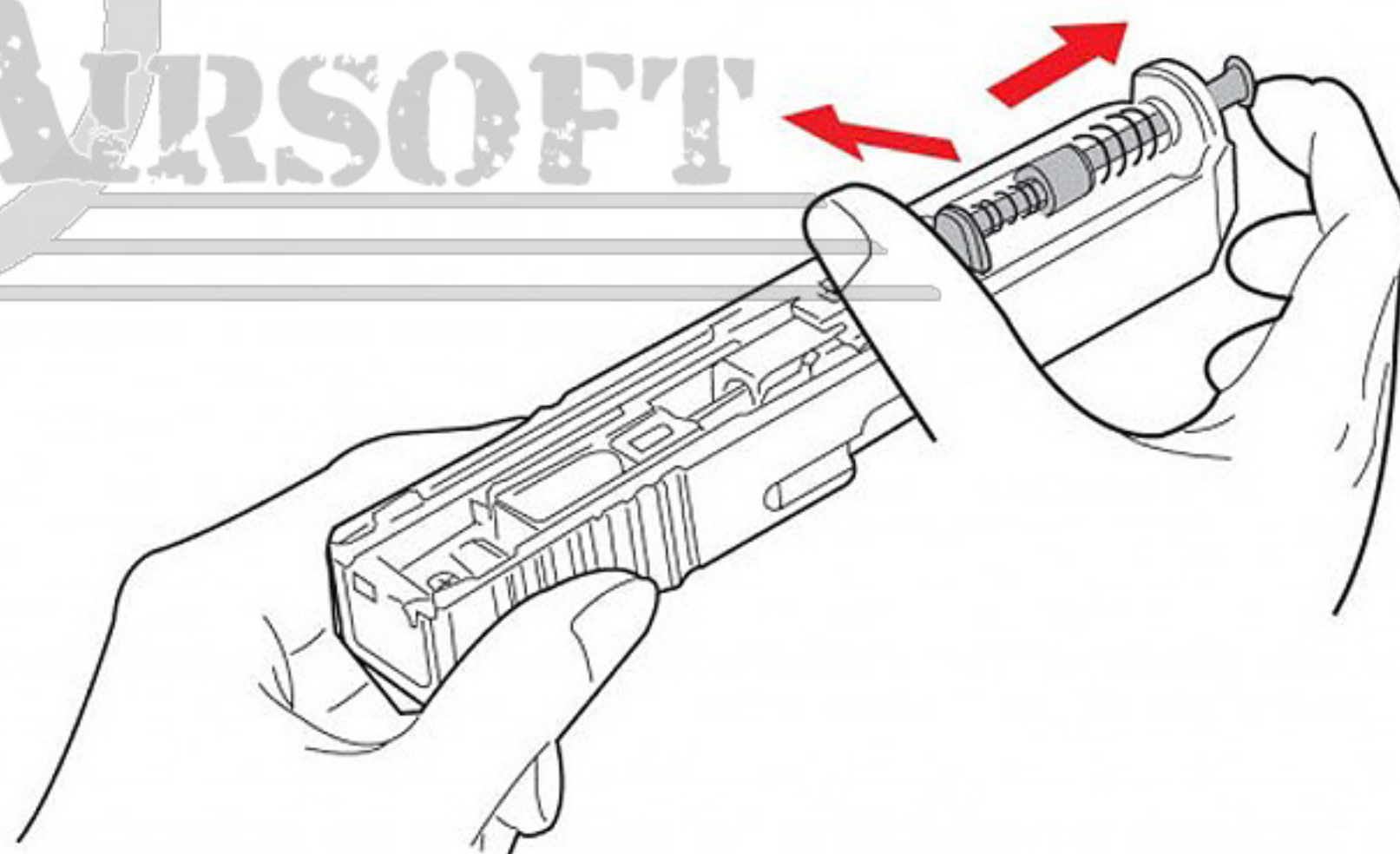
2. Press the slide release button and push forward the slide.



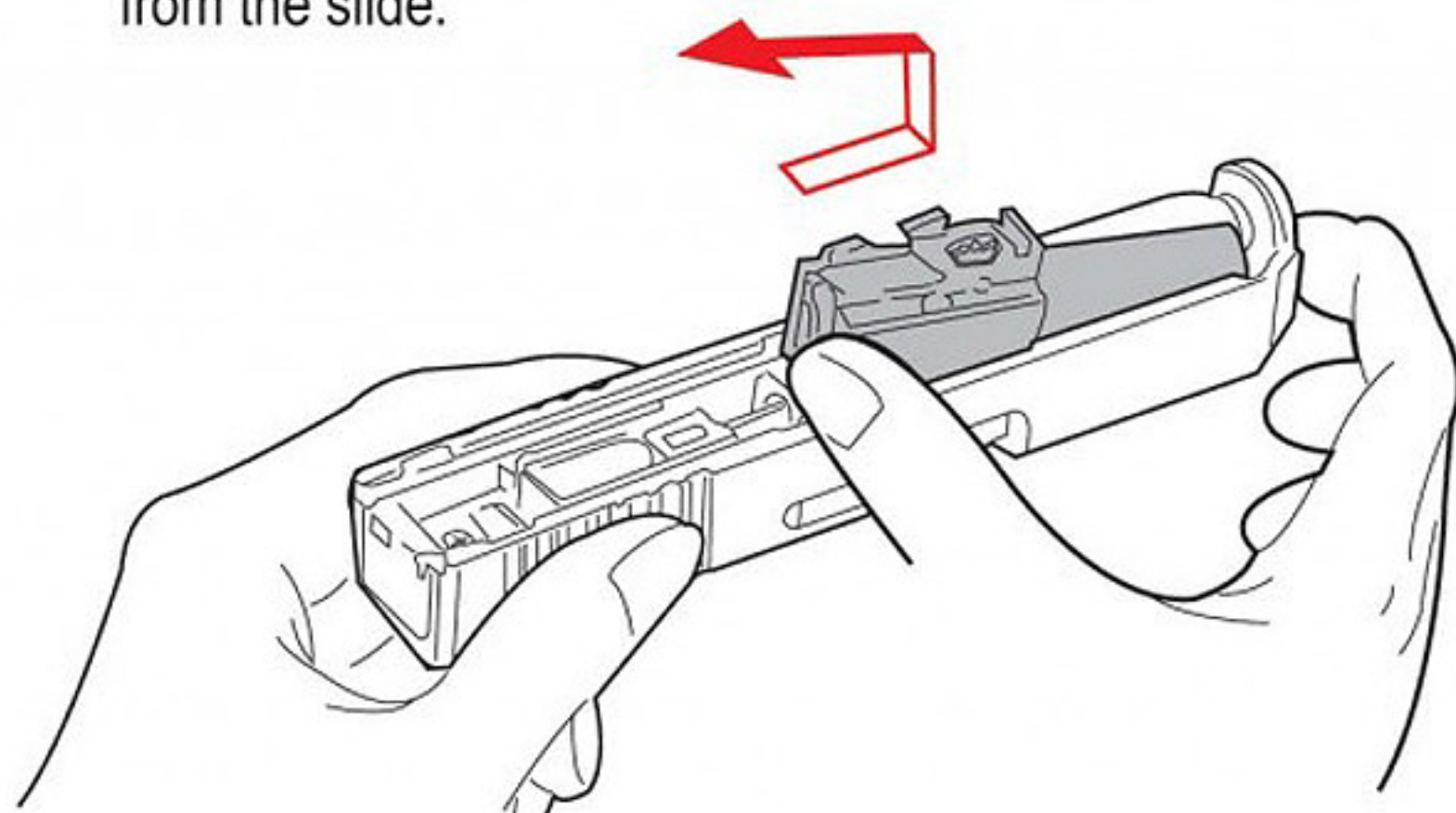
3. Then, remove the whole slide apart from the frame.



4. Press the recoil spring rod forward and remove it from the slide.



5. Finally, remove the inner barrel system from the slide.

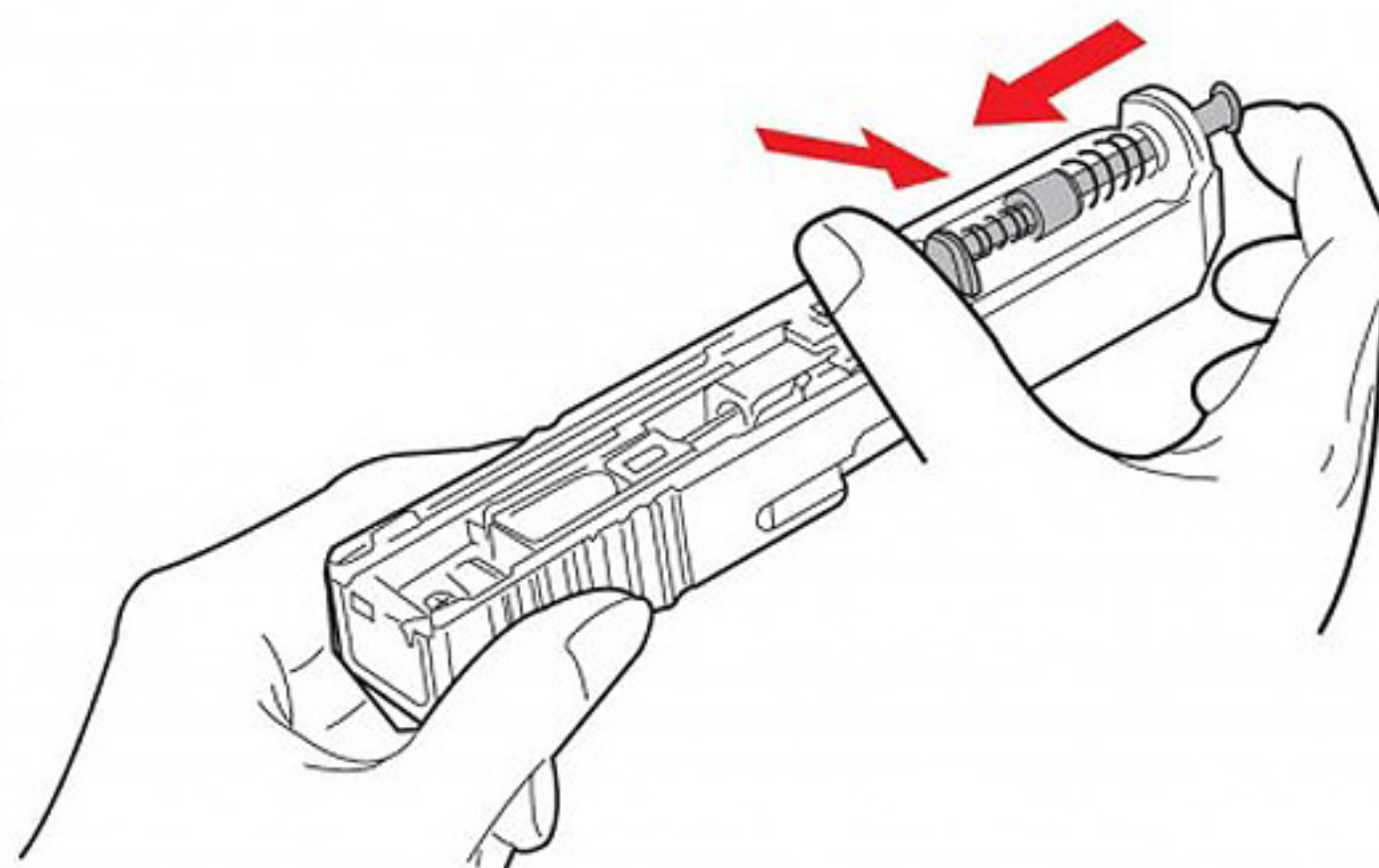
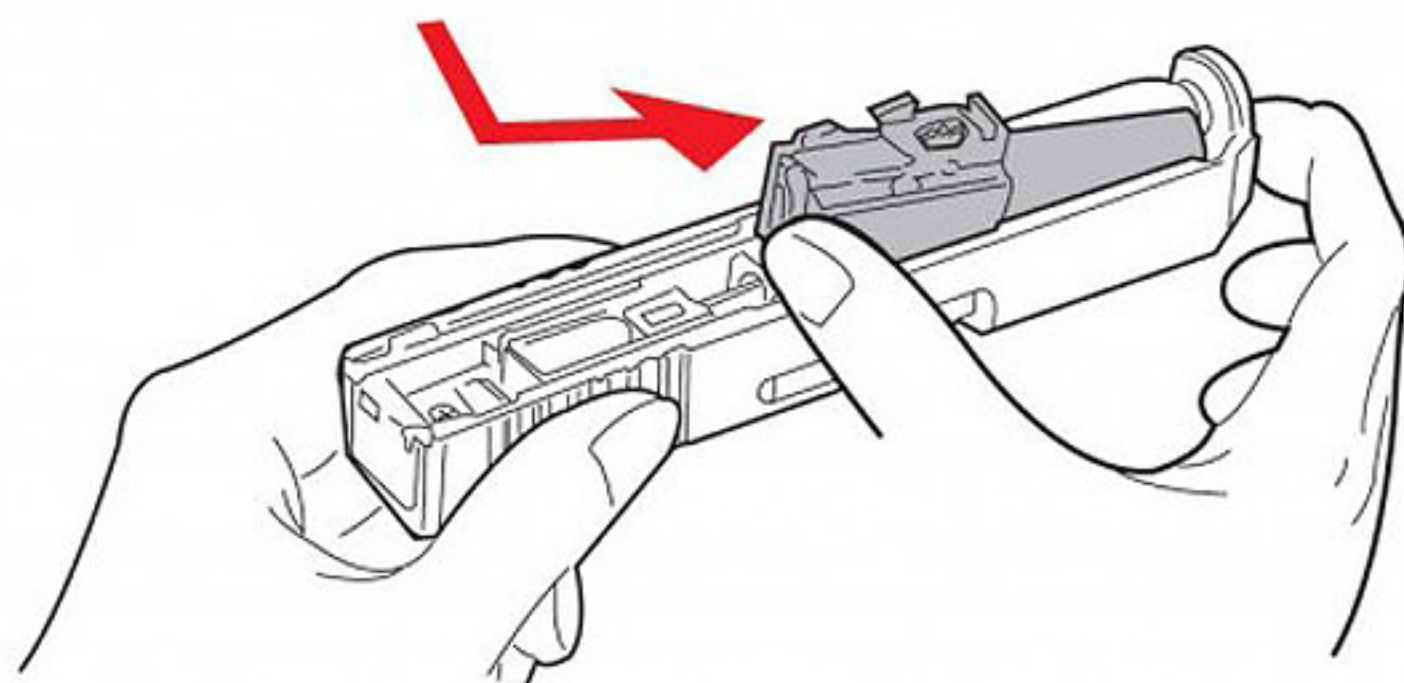




② How to assembly after the basic maintenance.

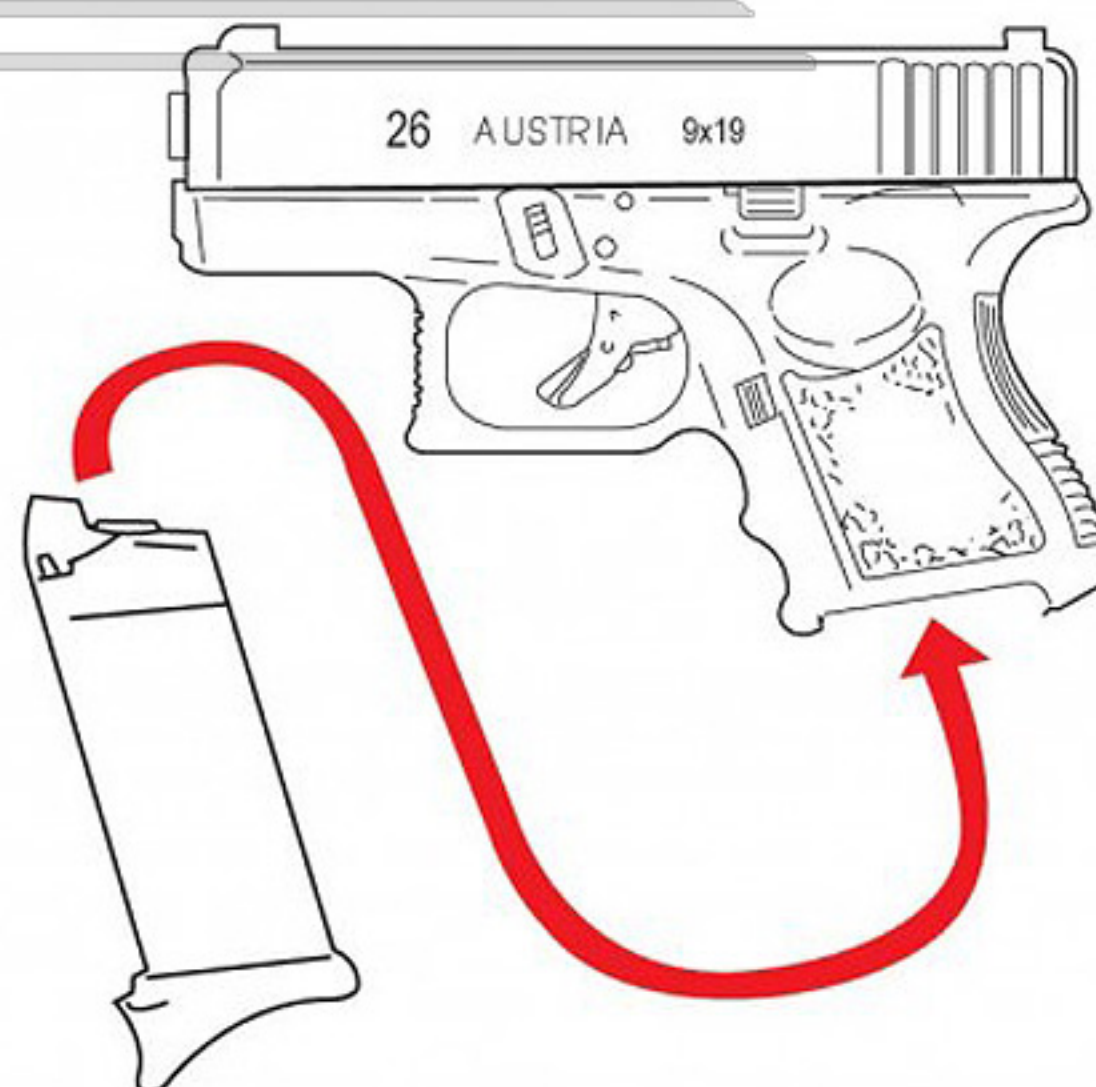
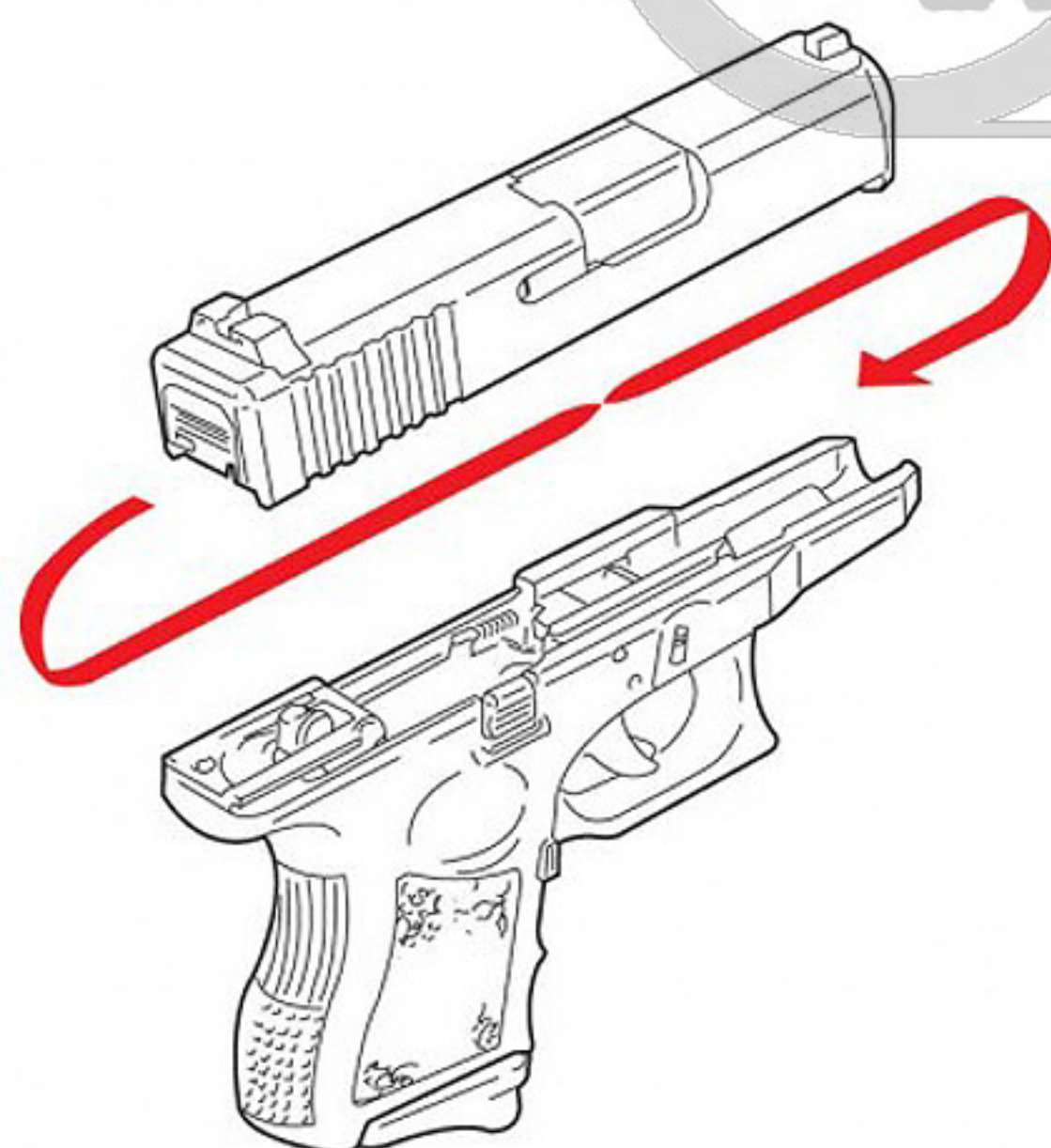
1. Install the inner barrel system into the slide.

2. Install the recoil spring rod back into the slide.



3. Then, insert the whole slide by aligning to the groove shown below

4. Attach the magazine.

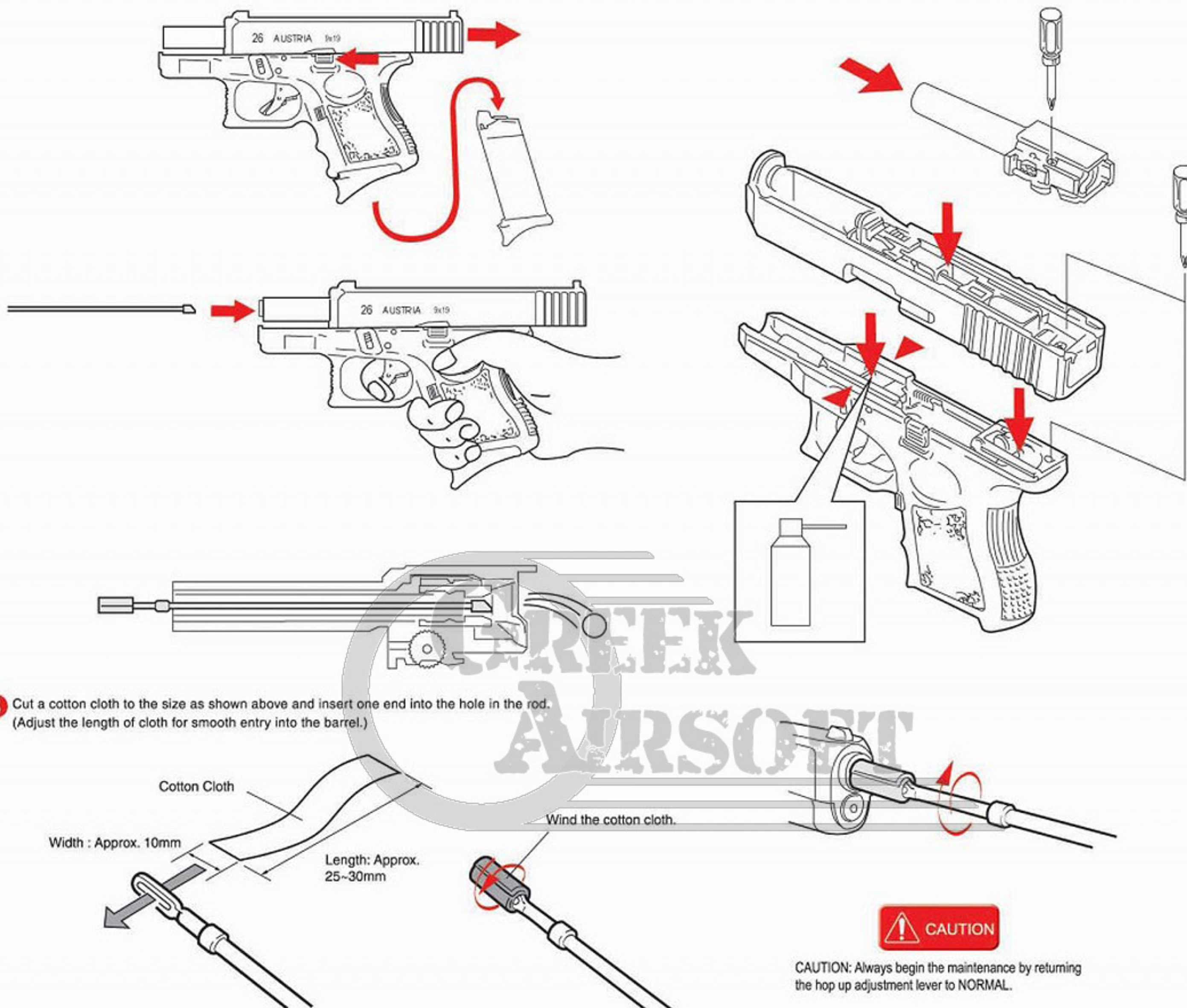




## 5 Maintenance

- ① If the pellets are clogged, remove the magazine and use the cleaning rod to eject the pellet.

- ② Then spray silicone oil for 0.5 to 1 sec in the arrow area; and clean the oil from the chamber using the cleaning rod (with cotton) to complete the maintenance.



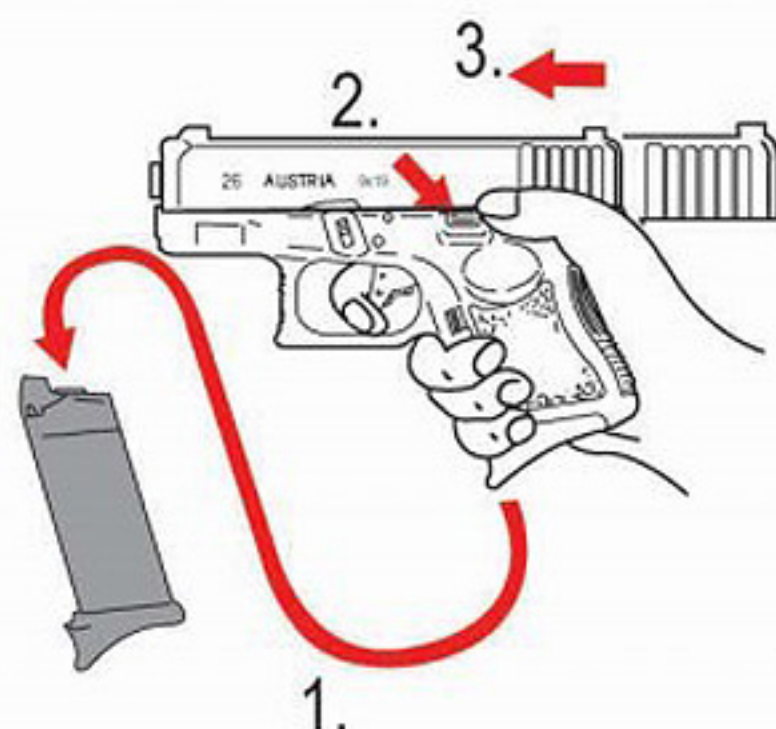
\*Always empty remaining gas in the magazine before storage.

- ④ After shooting and storage

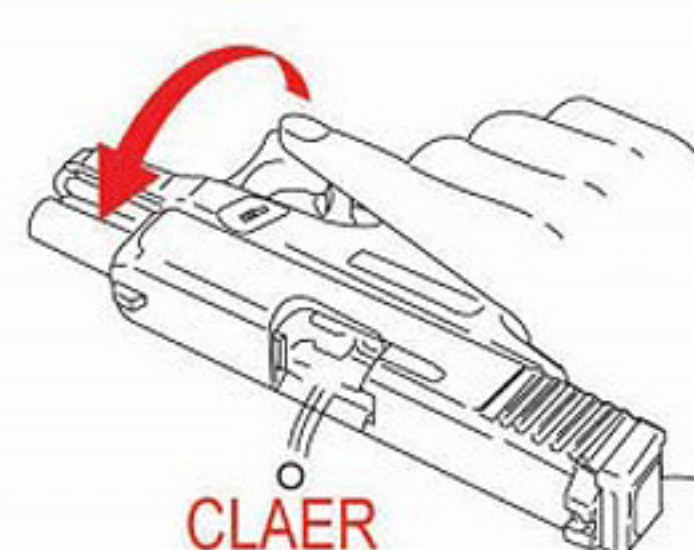
- ① After the shooting practice, 1) take off the magazine from the stock, 2) push down the slide lock to hold the slide in place and 4) press the trigger to release the hammer.
